

Strawberry Mountain Forest Biomass Fuel Bricks & Ochoco Pure Wood Bricks

Wood Bricks:

Are suitable for use in wood stoves, patio fire pits, campfires, fire places, and can be used for cooking.

Produce in excess of 25,000 BTU of heat energy per brick

Burn's cleaner & hotter with less smoke and sparks than seasoned fire wood which means fewer emissions, clean chimneys and safer outdoor burning.

Burn up completely with little left over ash or charred pieces.

Are a renewable fuel produced from forest fiber resulting from forest thinning and stewardship management thus contributing to our forest health improvement.

Are lite to lift (a little more than 3lbs) & easy to handle (square, no rolling), no insects, no dirt, no falling bark, no wood to split, uniform fuel size, consistent heat & store in a compact space (same heat value as a cord of seasoned firewood stored in 1/3 the space).

Are heat treated to allow transports to the use areas without the spread of insects or diseases.

Brick specs:

Wt: A little over 3lbs each

Size: Approx 10"x 3" x 3-1/4"

MC: <8%

Density: Approx 55lbs/cuft

Cautions:

Bricks burn hotter than firewood. Only burn enough bricks to produce a safe level of heat for the appliance being used.

Before burning bricks assure that the stoves or appliances used are serviceable and flues and chimneys are clean and suited for the burning of the bricks.
